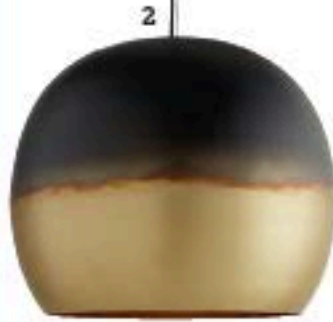




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SUMMER SUNSET

As summertime melts languidly into its figurative golden hour, designers are taking late-summer sunset skies — with their smoldering shades of amber, rust and ochre — as their mood board. The dreamy, big-tummied vase by Los Angeles artist Elyse Graham — the one-of-a-kind piece is hand-cast — looks like a peach-hued, sun-blushed cloud set in plaster. A mid-century modern-style pitcher set from designer Andi Kovel comes in hot, cocktail-ready shades: the pitcher looks like vitrified Aperol. And for fashion house Bottega Veneta, former creative director Tomas Maier designed a liquid silk pajama-jumpsuit that's as close as you'll ever get to swathing yourself in a setting sunbeam.
